Unlike the school year that most of us are used to, the school year in Nicaragua runs from February to November. It feels like a year that just began is beginning its wind-down. Graduations—always a grand affair—for our oldest pre-schoolers are pending. At the most recent monthly meeting with parents, those that have children preparing

to 'graduate' expressed their excitement at this first educational milestone. It is bound to be a special event.

It is clear that, despite the critical economic situation that Nicaraguans find themselves facing, the parents of the children in our programs work hard to maintain a positive attitude, exuding confidence and a willingness to continue working with us in the education of their children. It is certainly a reward in our collective efforts to make the operations of the programs possible!

Discovering support

A group of local Los Medranos women continue to create and have fun as they learn from one other. The group, which meets weekly on Fridays, are self-motivated as they gather to learn new skills. While learning, they openly share their challenges and struggles with one another, which has unexpectedly



turned class time into unofficial, but important, group therapy-type sessions. The women are genuinely eager to attend, bringing snacks for sharing where possible, as they support one another.

By request of the participants, they are currently working on "fofuchas" - dolls made from craft materials used as decorative pieces and party favours—for which there is local demand.

The program is becoming notorious as it continues to impact lives in the community. We believe that future generations will benefit as well.
